TULSA -- Retired Air Force Lt. Col. Robert M. Bowman and longtime peace advocate will be speaking at 7 p.m. on Saturday at Church of the Restoration, 1314 N Greenwood Ave. in Tulsa as part of his 2009 Patriot Tour.

Called "the best public speaker in the country" by the *Los Angeles Times*, Bowman is touring the country this year to challenge citizens to "take back America" for the people. He explains why America needs a government that follows the Constitution, honors the truth and serves the people.

Bowman, a Reform Party presidential candidate in 2000, is calling for a number of changes to U.S. domestic and foreign policy, including: No more imperial presidency. No nuclear attack on Iran. No more undeclared wars of aggression. No more spying on the American people. No more jailing of dissidents. No more corporations importing and exploiting millions of illegal immigrants to drive down wages. No more exporting of jobs. No more NAFTA. No more North American Union. No more government lies, false-flag attacks, and cover-ups. No more corporate welfare. No more health plans written by insurance companies and pharmaceutical manufacturers. No more energy policies written by Exxon and Enron. No more trillions of dollars in debt.

Bowman, who has a doctorate in aeronautics and nuclear engineering from California Institute of Technology, is founder and chairman of The Patriots, a national organization devoted to government which follows the Constitution, honors the truth and serves the people.

As part of this campaign, Bowman has been a major speaker at 9/11 Truth Conferences in Toronto, New York City, Washington, D.C., Chicago, Los Angeles, Melbourne, Boston, Detroit, Phoenix, Austin and Sydney, Australia. He has addressed hundreds of peace conferences, and has four times been keynote speaker at Veterans for Peace annual conventions.

Bowman's other obligations include acting as president of the Institute for Space and Security Studies, executive vice president of Millennium III Corp. He also has won many awards including the Eisenhower Medal, the George F. Kennan Peace Prize, the President's Medal of Veterans for Peace and many others.
