



## Endorse Reform to Give Oklahoma Voters Choice

OBAR is a coalition committed to the cause of fair ballot access and greater voter choices. We are members of the Libertarian, Green, and Constitution Parties, along with many independents and members of the Republican and Democratic Parties. We are diverse in our political views, but we agree on one thing – the right to vote is meaningless if you cannot vote for the candidate of **your** choice.

Our hope is that once you, the citizens of Oklahoma, understand the crisis of our undemocratic ballot access laws, that you will join us in fighting for a return to democracy. In particular, we are supporting the **Fair Ballot Access and Greater Voter Choice Bill**, which would return the number of signatures for recognition of political party back to the number required from statehood until 1974 (5,000 signatures). The current law requires signatures from 5% turnout of the last statewide election, which was 73,188 signatures to qualify for the 2006 elections. This is by far the highest number required by any state in our region.

We hope you or your organization will endorse open democracy in Oklahoma.
